



TASMAN ESCAPE SECURITY AND SCREEN 3 POINT DOOR LOCK

FITTING INSTRUCTIONS






Mounting of handle <u>below</u> door centreline


▼ Both sides of the door stile must be cut to the dimensions given. Start with the centreline of door.

All dimensions in millimetres




Mounting of handle <u>above</u> door centreline


▼ Both sides of the door stile must be cut to the dimensions given. Start with the centreline of door.




- Keeping the Actuator Drive of the Actuating Bar facing the front edge of the stile, insert the rod assembly through the top cut-out and slide it through the door section. With the Top Lock in the locked position connect the rod and push into place.
- Pull bottom rod end through bottom cut-out. Connect to Bottom Lock and push into place.

- Turn key to ensure the lock is functioning. Leave in locked position and remove the key.
- Ensure that both top and bottom bolts are deadlocked.
- Drill Ø3mm hole in the centre of the slotted holes of the Top and Bottom locks.
- Lightly fix both locks with the 12mm fixing screws supplied in slotted holes only. NOTE: Do not drill other fixing holes until final adjustment.







- Insert key and check function of the handle and the top bottom and centre locks. Ensure that:
 - Bolts retract and move freely,
- Bolt and handle will not operate in locked position. NOTE: The auxiliary bolt must be depressed for the locking mechanism to operate.
- Unlock cylinder, slide top and bottom locks using light finger pressure to just fully retract bolts. Tighten screws.
- Check operation with the key. Ensure that the Top and Bottom bolts are:
- Deadlocked in the locked position.
- Flush in unlocked position, adjust if necessary.
- ▼ Drill Ø3mm hole through the other fixing hole of the Top and Bottom locks and secure with 2 x 12mm screws supplied. (Refer diagram A)



- ✓ Hold door in closed position and mark the door jamb level with match mark on front of the centre lock body. From the strikers supplied with the accessory kit, select the one with the tongue. Position striker with the top in line with the mark just made. Mark the position of the screw holes and the bolt recess. Drill holes and cut out bolt recess to a depth of 20mm. Fix the strike using the 25mm screws supplied.
- Mark the location for the Top and Bottom bolts. Using the two strikers mark the position of the screw holes and bolt recesses. Cut out bolt recesses to a depth of 20mm and drill holes. Fix the strikers using the 25mm screws supplied.
- NOTE: Operation of the lock requires the auxiliary bolt to be depressed against the striker. This requires a maximum clearance of 3mm between the door stile and striker. NOTE: 10mm and 12mm step over and hi-security strikers are available for top, bottom and centre locks for additional security.
