| Partially close door. Mark centre of latch bolt. Mark horizontal line along the inside face of the door jamb. | Measure the door thickness and halve it. | From the door stop along the horizontal line, measure and mark a vertical line at half the door thickness. | At this point drill 25mm hole, 13mm deep into the door jamb. Mark 30mm x 25mm box. Then chisel out jamb to the same depth for striker box. | Striker and striker box to be fitted into door jamb. |

| Align strike plate centrally and vertically over this box hole. Mark around plate. Chisel out jamb to allow strike plate & box to sit flush. | Drill 2x 2mm pilot holes and affix screws provided. | | | YSH-121 0917 |
